Each Bidder must furnish, with his Bid, Bid Security in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid. In addition, each Bid must be accompanied by a properly executed non-collusion affidavit.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within forty-five (45) days of the bid opening.
